The State itself has created the pathway. The words “is yet another attack on PTM by this terrorist State” clearly constitutes cognizable and heinous offences under the PECA. The terminology used by Imaan Mazari is a calculated attempt to delegitimize the State’s anti-terrorism efforts and encourage hostility against institutions.
